

# Chapter Ten The Principles of Preparation






### **The First Principles**

For when for the time ye ought to be teachers, ye have need that one teach you again which be **the first principles of the oracles of God**; and are become such as have need of milk, and not of strong meat.

-Hebrews 5:12

Therefore, leaving the discussion of the elementary principles of Christ, let us go on to perfection, not laying again the foundation of repentance from dead works and of faith toward God, 2 of the doctrine of baptisms, of laying on of hands, of resurrection of the dead, and of eternal judgment.

-Hebrews 6:1-2 (NKJV)

#### **Principles About The Future:**

- (4) Resurrection of the Dead The Kingdom Age to Come
  - A certain nobleman went into a far country to receive for <a href="https://example.com/himself-a-kingdom-and-to-return">himself-a-kingdom-and-to-return</a>. (Luke 19:12)
  - ... you shall be repaid at the <u>resurrection</u> of the just." (Luke 14:14 NKJV)
- (5) Eternal Judgment
  - "The men of Nineveh will rise up in the <u>iudgment</u> with this generation and condemn it, because they repented at the preaching of Jonah; and indeed a greater than Jonah is here. (Matthew 12:41 NKJV)

#### **Principles of Preparation:**

- (1)Repentance From Dead Works and Faith Toward God
- (2) Doctrines of Baptisms/Washings
- (3) The Laying on of Hands (impartation)

# Chapter Eleven Three "When-dicators" of His Return





#### Three When-dicators

1. When the Church is mature and walking in unity.

And He Himself gave some to be apostles, some prophets, some evangelists, and some pastors and teachers, 12 for the equipping of the saints for the work of ministry, for the edifying of the body of Christ, ... till we all come to the unity of the faith and of the knowledge of the Son of God, to a perfect man, to the measure of the stature of the fullness of Christ (Ephesians 4:11-13 NKJV)

"\_\_\_\_\_" speaks of a time when the "five-fold" will no longer be needed. That can only be after Christ returns.

This is action. This is what we do. This is preparation.



#### Three When-dicators

### 2. When the Church is walking in purity and holiness.

...for the marriage of the Lamb has come, and His wife has made herself ready." 8 And to her it was granted to be arrayed in fine linen, clean and bright, for the fine linen is the righteous acts of the saints. (Rev 19:7-8)

...denying ungodliness and worldly lusts, we should live soberly, righteously, and godly in the present age, looking for the blessed hope and glorious appearing of our great God and Savior Jesus Christ (Titus 2:12-13).

... when He is revealed, we shall be like Him, for we shall see Him as He is. 3 And everyone who has this hope in Him purifies himself, just as He is pure. (1 John 3:2-3)

#### Three When-dicators

3. When the Church has taken the Kingdom message to the ends of the earth.

A certain nobleman went into a far country to receive for himself a kingdom, and to return (Luke 19:12).

The kingdom of heaven is like leaven, which a woman took and hid in three measures of meal till it was all leavened (Matt. 13:33).

And this gospel of the kingdom will be preached in all the world as a witness to all the nations, and then the end will come (Matt. 24:14).

The Kingdom will appear when our \_\_\_\_\_ is done.
